Mayor Guy Pilon wishes to raise \$100,000 for a Maison de la famille in Vaudreuil-Dorion

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 7, 2018 – The Mayor of Vaudreuil-Dorion, Guy Pilon, made an appeal to donors in the region in order to raise \$100,000 for the Maison de la Famille Vaudreuil-Soulanges to enable the latter to open a point of service in Vaudreuil-Dorion.
