Vaudreuil-Dorion: 4th best city in Canada to raise kids

Vaudreuil-Dorion, July 31, 2018 – According to MoneySense, a Canadian online personal finance and lifestyle magazine put out by Rogers Publishing Limited, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion offers some of the best conditions for raising kids, with a 4th place ranking on the national scene. It also stands out in terms of welcoming newcomers, ranking 24th. For 16 years, MoneySense has been publishing «Canada's Best Places to Live», a report that measures different aspects of Canadian cities.

Overall, Vaudreuil-Dorion ranked 58th among Canadian cities where life is good. It came 13th among the 103 Quebec cities on the list.

Ten criteria were analyzed: prosperity and the economy, access to property, population growth, property tax, mobility (transportation), crime rate, climate, accessibility to health care, services provided to the population and culture. The Best Places to Raise Kids category also takes into account the percentage of the population aged 15 and under (23% in Vaudreuil-Dorion), as well as access to daycares. The Best Places to Live for New Canadians category surveys low unemployment rates, affordable housing and proximity to an airport.

Mayor Guy Pilon is extremely proud: "This ranking is the result of years of constant effort based on our family vision and on our main concern, which is to make Vaudreuil-Dorion a good place to live."

This is the second year that Vaudreuil-Dorion has made the list. In 2017, it was Canada's 15th best city for raising kids.
