Food waste collection: brown bins distributed to residents

Vaudreuil-Dorion, September 11, 2018 – The new food waste collection will begin on October 2 (peripheral zone) and October 4 (central zone). To this end, brown bins will be delivered to residents during the week of September 17.

Each bin will contain a starter kit including a kitchen bin, compostable bags for this container as well as for the brown bin, an information brochure, a checklist sticker to place on your kitchen bin as well as an invitation to attend one of the information meetings.

Residents are highly encouraged to use the food waste collection services, in the same way as they are the recycling collection. In fact, according to the Québec residual materials management policy, between now and 2020, it will be prohibited to dispose of organic waste in any other manner. It is therefore important to integrate these new habits immediately.

Note that food waste collection services will be implemented in several phases, the first of which targets single-family homes and buildings of four units or less.
