## La Mèz: new fall programming at Maison Félix-Leclerc

**Vaudreuil-Dorion, September 26, 2018** – Activities will resume on October 5 at Maison Félix-Leclerc with the La Mèz line-up including a variety of themed gatherings every Friday at 7:00 p.m.: up-close and personal encounters with special guests, living room jam sessions, storytelling and theatre evenings.

Storyteller Lucie Bisson will kick off the first up-close and personal meetings on October 5 with her presentation entitled *J'vous ai pas tout dit*. On Friday, October 12, Sylva Balassanian delivers a piano/voice performance in French, Arabic and Armenian. On October 19, storytelling and professional liar Éric Michaud will be on hand for a fun evening. On October 26, Le Baobab – Création multidisciplinaire, led by Thomas Duret, will be presenting *OVNI*.

In November and December, Domlebo and André Thériault will be at the Maison for the living-room jam sessions, Marc-André Fortin and Jocelyn Sioui for storytelling and Les Philanthropes for theatre activities. A special up-close and personal evening is planned for November 2 (guest to be confirmed shortly).

Lucie Bisson is the resident artist for October and will be at the Maison every weekend of the month. Visitors are invited to take part in her workshops on October 6, 13 and 27.

Monica Brinkman will take over as resident artist for the month of November. She is pleased to be offering workshops through which visitors can create a decoupage/collage shoe or skate (on November 3), mosaic Christmas ornaments (on November 11 and 24) or a decoupage/collage book (on November 18).
