## **Construction work at railway level crossing: A portion of Cité-des-Jeunes Boulevard to be closed on October 13 and 14**

**Vaudreuil-Dorion, October 9, 2018** – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion wishes to inform citizens and motorists that Cité-des-Jeunes Boulevard, near Paul-Émile-Borduas Avenue, will be closed while work is being done on the railway level crossing between Saturday, October 13 at 6:30 a.m. and Sunday, October 14 at 4:00 p.m. Traffic will be detoured through Émile-Bouchard Street and De la Gare Boulevard as well as Forbes and Ouimet streets.

The work will be carried out by exo (formerly the Réseau de transport métropolitain) as part of its railway safety program and completed during the weekend in order to limit the impact on railway traffic.

Although exo is making every effort to ensure the quality of life of citizens who live near the railway is affected as little as possible, certain nuisances cannot be prevented: noises created by truck motors and job site machinery, back-up warning alarms, minor ground vibrations and dust.

Several trains running on the Vaudreuil Hudson line (exo1) will not be stopping at the Vaudreuil station on Saturday, October 13. This applies to service in both directions. Shuttle buses will be running to transport passengers between the Dorion and Vaudreuil stations. For more information, please visit the Customer notices section of the exo Web site.
