Revitalization of Harwood sector: the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion and Développement Vaudreuil-Soulanges undertake an analysis of the area's commercial composition

Vaudreuil-Dorion, January 17, 2019 – As part of a collaborative agreement, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion and Développement Vaudreuil-Soulanges (DEV) undertook a census of the businesses and services located in the Harwood – De Lotbinière area in order to carry out an analysis of the commercial composition of the sector.

Until mid-February, DEV representatives will visit some 275 establishments in order to gather data that will be used to paint an accurate picture of business development throughout the City. This important exercise aims to identify the strengths, weaknesses, threats and future prospects of the Harwood – De Lotbinière sector.

“This analysis will enable us to understand commercial needs in the sector and, as such, attract new businesses that will meet these needs so as to provide a quality environment to citizens from surrounding neighbourhoods,” stated Mayor Guy Pilon.

This initiative is consistent with the Harwood – De Lotbinière sector's revitalization project aimed at redeveloping this part of the territory with a clear, integrated vision in order to ensure the neighbourhood's optimal growth.
