The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion introduces a new Master Plan for parks and green spaces

Vaudreuil-Dorion, March 20, 2019 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion's 2018-2025 Master Plan for parks and green spaces was presented to City Council at the regular meeting held on Monday in the Council Chamber at City Hall.

The Plan will serve as a planning tool for the purpose of assessing the current scenario as well as identifying and prioritizing a series of actions to be implemented by the city of Vaudreuil-Dorion over the next seven years. More precisely, the Plan will be useful in providing an overview of the territory and will make it possible to observe urban development trends and changes in the ways people use parks. It will provide an assessment of the current state of the parks within the territory, including any sports and recreational facilities they provide. The Plan will also be an important strategic planning tool for City Managers and elected officials, enabling them to plan their investments adequately in existing parks and future ones.

"The landscape of the City has changed dramatically over recent years. This Plan will serve as a guiding principle for both Municipal Management and City Council to rely on when making decisions regarding any investments to be made in our parks for the years to come, based on the needs of our population" declared Guy Pilon, Mayor of the City.
