People with disabilities: City Council adopts 2019 Action Plan

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 18, 2019 – During the public session on June 17, the Vaudreuil-Dorion City council adopted its 2019 Action Plan for People with Disabilities. This measure is being implemented in accordance with the Act to Secure the Handicapped in the Exercise of their Rights with a view to achieving social, school and workplace integration.

This document lists the concrete measures the City can take to facilitate the social participation of people with disabilities in each of its sectors of activities. Actions in 2018 were taken to allow the broadcasting of City Council meetings via the City's website and MaTV, which makes it possible for people with reduced mobility to stay informed about democratic life without having to leave home. Also, new employment opportunities are forwarded to SEMO Montérégie so they can inform people with disabilities. In regard to a completely different issue, the City has made it a practice to provide chemical toilets during events that are suitable for people with disabilities.

"Our goal is to make life easier for people with disabilities in every area of the City's operations and take measures to ensure accessibility while also respecting our administrative, organizational and financial constraints", said Mayor Guy Pilon.
