Waste collection: Be careful about what you put in the black bin!

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 2, 2020 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion offers its residents several types of collection services in an effort to limit the amount of waste sent to landfill. However, some materials cannot be placed in the black bin. Citizens who fail to comply with instructions may find that their bins are not collected, and may also receive a notice of violation.

List of materials refused

The following materials are not accepted in garbage bins : Green waste (leaves, grass, hedge clippings, etc.), construction and renovation materials, soil, brick, asphalt, large items (e.g. sinks), hazardous household waste (e.g. propane tanks), electronics, ashes that have not been cooled down, unprotected sharp or pointed objects.

How to dispose of non-accepted items

The City offers several other types of collection services:

- Recyclable materials Every week;
- Food waste Every week;
- Green waste Every two weeks from April to September;
- Branches Spring and Fall;
- Large items Third Tuesday and Thursday of every month, depending on the sector.

For other items, such as building materials, tires, hazardous household waste, etc., citizens are asked to deliver these items to the Ecocentre located at 2800 Henry-Ford Street. Opening hours are Tuesday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and weekends from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Vaudreuil-Soulanges RCM provides a tool called "Tricycle" (tricycle-mrcvs.ca) that can also assist in finding the right place to dispose of items within the region.

The City is aware that the contractor responsible for any one of the collections may sometimes fail to call on certain streets. If this happens, citizens are asked to leave their bins at the curb and report the incident to the Public Works Department at 450-455-3371, option 3 or t.publics@ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca. The staff will make sure to follow up with the company involved. Because the department is currently receiving a very high volume of calls, please make sure to leave only one message in order to speed up the processing of each request.
