Gradual Reopening of Municipal Offices

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 18, 2020 – As certain businesses and services begin to reopen according to the rules established by the Quebec government, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion will proceed with the reopening of some of its municipal buildings starting June 22.

At City Hall, staff assigned to the permit desk and the Finance and Treasury Department will be allowed to resume serving citizens in person while following all the required health protocols to ensure the safety of visitors and employees. The Recreation and Culture Department, located on the 2nd floor of the Centre Multisports, will also reopen on the same date. Visitors may gain access through the side door of the building. For all requests however, please note that online and telephone assistance are still preferred where possible.

Access to the library remains closed. Residents may however continue to reserve their books in advance and retrieve them through the library's contactless pick up service.

It should be noted that municipal buildings will be closed on Friday afternoons for the summer period until September 4. Opening hours are:

- City Hall: Monday to Thursday, 8 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 4:45 p.m., Friday, 8 a.m. to noon
- Recreation and Culture Department : Monday to Thursday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Friday, 8 a.m. to noon
