Fireworks Cancellation

Vaudreuil-Dorion, June 22, 2020 – Further to the announcement made on Friday, June 19 regarding the restriction for open fires issued by Quebec's Société de protection des forêts contre le feu (SOPFEU), which covers the Vaudreuil-Soulanges region, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion has no other choice but to cancel the fireworks that were planned for June 23 to mark the national holiday. «It is with much regret that we find ourselves faced with the obligation to cancel our fireworks. Four firework displays were planned to be launched from four different sites to avoid gatherings and make it possible for the greatest possible number of citizens to enjoy the show from their homes. The restrictions imposed by the SOPFEU now render it impossible to hold this event. Rest assured that we will come back next year with an even better fireworks display! Happy Fête nationale to everyone,» said Mayor Guy Pilon.
