Public Library to Reopen

Vaudreuil-Dorion, July 8, 2020 – In keeping with the gradual reopening of businesses and services as authorized by the Quebec government, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion will be reopening the public library on Sunday, July 12, under the usual operating hours: Monday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturdays and Sundays from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The contactless pick-up service will end on the same day.

All on-site services will resume with the exception of the *Espace Ados* (Teen Area). Citizens will once more have access to all collections, furnishings and computer stations. The Lab will be open on a reduced schedule.

All recreational activities will remain virtual for now. Citizens are urged to visit the City's website and follow the library's Facebook page to find out what activities are being offered.

A health protocol will be implemented to ensure the safety of users and employees. The number of seats will be reduced to respect the two-meter social distancing rule. Similarly, access to the genealogy room will be restricted. All returns must be deposited in the book chute accessible from outside the building, so that the documents may be placed in quarantine.
