Mosa s'éclate **A City of Poems : Local Poets to be Featured in 100 Public Places**

Vaudreuil-Dorion, September 23, 2020 – From September 25th to October 25th, as part of the Journées de la culture, Vaudreuil-Dorion's public places will be alive with the beauty of words as the works of 10 guest poets from the area, along with a group of citizens who chose to participate in the project, are displayed throughout one hundred different locations.

For the third edition of the *Festival des mots Mosa*, usually held at Maison Félix-Leclerc, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion decided to spread out the artistic event across the territory this year in order to avoid gatherings. "Since 2018, Mosa has provided us with the means to celebrate writing in all its forms. This year, because of the current situation, we had to do things differently. The *Mosa s'éclate* concept was born from a collaboration with the group Espaces Lettres with the goal of bringing poetry to the people", said Chloé Marcil - Head of Culture and Community Life Division for the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion.

Citizens are sure to have fun looking for the short poetic works inspired from the City along sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, and parks. So keep an eye on public areas over the next few weeks so you can have the chance to enjoy the words of our local poets.
