Vaudreuil-Dorion Adopts New Relaxation Measures for the City's Commercial Establishments

Vaudreuil-Dorion, December 3, 2020 – During its public session held on November 16, the Vaudreuil-Dorion City Council passed a resolution allowing merchants to install temporary shelters for the winter period. These shelters, which are not in compliance with current regulations, will be used to provide comfort for customers who must line up outside before entering the store because of the pandemic.

The City Council will also maintain the relaxation measures adopted in June to increase the visibility of commercial establishments until further notice. The temporary installation of up to three signs (posters, banners or feather flags) will therefore continue to be allowed on the site of certain commercial establishments across a maximum area of three square meters each.

These measures are meant to provide assistance to our business owners, who have been severely affected by the crisis that we have been experiencing since last March.
