This pandemic is making it very difficult to organize activities because of the need to comply with physical distancing rules. Nicolas Noël, alias the Real Santa Claus, is a popular hero among children, and he brings a special gentleness and enchantment to every one of his appearances, including his live performances, TV shows, podcasts or videos. Although the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion had to do things differently this year, several activities will nonetheless be taking place in December to mark the holiday season.
