A New Registration Platform for Pet Licensing through the City's website

Vaudreuil-Dorion, December 16, 2020 – A brand new online service has been added to the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion's website. The Pet Licensing platform allows citizens to register their pet, pay and replace the license, as well as update their contact information or report a potentially dangerous dog.

This new method greatly facilitates the registration process. Once the payment has been made (\$15 for a dog, \$10 for a cat), the tag can be delivered free of charge by mail directly to the resident's home. Citizens who have already paid for their pet's license will not have to pay the fee again and no medals are awarded for updating a registration. They are asked to create their account on the platform and make sure the information is accurate and up to date.

Microchipping

Last May, the Municipal Council adopted the Supplementary Regulation Concerning Dogs, making it mandatory to microchip dogs. Upon registration, owners must provide the microchip number, as well as proof of vaccination for their dog.

Citizens have until June 30, 2021 to comply with this requirement. To this end, the City is offering a \$10 grant for placement of the microchip by a veterinarian whose establishment is located in Vaudreuil-Dorion. Details are available on the City's website in the Animals section.
