## Opening of the indoor pool and arena for March break

**Vaudreuil-Dorion, February 23, 2021** – Following last week's announcement by the Quebec government allowing municipalities to open certain indoor facilities for the March break period, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to inform its citizens that both the arena and indoor swimming pool will be accessible between February 26th and March 7th.

Just like the Fall, those interested will need to book their time slot online via the City's website up to 48 hours in advance for both free swim and free skate. Rink times may also be booked 72 hours in advance. Charges apply for this type of rental.

Fatbikes will also be available for citizens to try out at the park located at 405 avenue Saint-Charles every day between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Again, please remember to book your time slot 48 hours in advance. It is also a good idea to reserve your spot for skating on the parc de la Maison-Valois ice ring.

Three snow hills with lanes have been set up at the following parks: Mozart, Aurèle-Joliat and du Bicentenaire. Snow tubes are available to users at parc du Bicentenaire between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekends, and every day during March break and ped days.

### Theme-based workshops

Spaces are still available for some of the workshops, quizzes and learning workshops that are being offered online. Also, a limited number of individual activity kits are still available. Please note that the minimum age for participation in some of the activities has been adjusted downwards.
