## **Natura: When digital art unites with nature**

**Vaudreuil-Dorion, May 31, 2021** – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion invites its citizens to visit the Natura exhibition, which will be presented every night from 8:30 p.m. from June 4th to 14th, 2021, in the park located at 405 avenue Saint-Charles.

Three artists from Vaudreuil-Dorion, including Diane Collet, Philippe Corriveau and Stéphan Daigle, have created a digital work of art inspired by nature which will be projected on giant canvases installed in the park. To help create their projections, the artists benefited from the assistance of staff from the Lab, the digital creation space located at the public library.

"Last year, we explored digital art in the framework of a project with the Société des arts technologiques. This is a new niche which allows our artists to exercise their craft in a different way. The current context lends itself well to outdoor displays of this kind. The enchanting setting provided by the park at 405 avenue Saint-Charles is the perfect background for this exhibition featuring movement, music and light", said Chloé Marcil, Head of the Culture and Community Life division for the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion.
