Harwood Nature Park officially becomes the property of the City

Vaudreuil-Dorion, August 6, 2021 – It's official, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion now owns part of lot 1 834 918 and lot 3 066 845, which are located at 3900 Route Harwood (formerly the site of Club de golf Harwood), halfway between Chemin Daoust and Côte Saint-Charles. The site will be known as Harwood Nature Park for the time being, and the population is already welcome to come and enjoy its 196,396.1 square metres of surface area (2,113,990 ft²).

For now, the park will be equipped with basic facilities such as tables, garbage cans, bike racks and bathrooms. The municipal administration will take the coming year to reflect upon the purpose it wishes to give to this green space. Citizens will also be consulted to assess their needs regarding parks and outdoor activities.

"This acquisition allows us to ensure the preservation of another green space on the territory, in addition to the ones located at Parc de l'Île Bray, Le 405 and the Pères de Sainte-Croix property, as well as the fifty or so parks equipped with play modules and sports fields, all accessible to our residents. This new addition offers a variety of possibilities and this is what will be assessed and discussed over the coming months," commented Mayor Guy Pilon.

People are invited to come and enjoy this new space between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. As is the case with the majority of Vaudreuil-Dorion parks, animals are not permitted at this time. Motorcycles and other motor vehicles may not circulate on the property. Finally, it is forbidden to consume drugs and alcohol, to make fires or to be dressed indecently.

This type of acquisition aimed at developing a harmonious and sustainable living environment is part of the 2020 > 2025 Strategic Plan.
