Fourth edition of the Treasure Hunt: registration starting September 1st

Vaudreuil-Dorion, August 24, 2021 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to announce the fourth edition of the treasure hunt. This activity that aims at giving objects a second life will be held on Saturday, September 18. Residents are invited to place furniture or other items they wish to give away at the curb, starting at 8:00 a.m. These treasures are free for those who are interested—first-come, first-served.

Citizens who wish to take part must register with the Environment Section between September 1st and 15, either by email at environnement@ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca or by phone at 450 455-3371, option 1, making sure to indicate their address and the items they wish to offer: furniture, household appliances, toys, dishes, cultural items (music, literature, art), electronic devices, bathroom items, tools and materials or other. The addresses provided, along with the type of items available, will be posted on the City's Web site on Thursday, September 16.

Please note that items that are not picked up must be removed before 9:00 that evening. Hazardous household waste as well as any unprotected sharp or pointy items cannot be placed at the curb during the activity, which is slated to take place rain or shine.

The treasure hunt adheres to the principle of the 3 Rs + V (Reduce, Re-use, Recycle and extract Value). Its purpose is to help extend the life of objects, limit the production of new products and keep items that are still in good condition out of the landfill.
