2021 Census: Vaudreuil-Dorion ranks 27th among Quebec cities in terms of population

Vaudreuil-Dorion, February 14, 2022 – According to the most recent 2021 census data released by Statistics Canada, the city of Vaudreuil-Dorion ranks 27th in Quebec and 120th in Canada in terms of its population, making it the second municipality with the largest number of residents in the greater Suroît region, just behind Châteauguay. Since the last census in 2016, the population has grown from 38,117 to 43,268 citizens, an increase of 13.5%.

"We have been watching our City grow for years now. Our small municipality has become a bustling city centre where young professionals, families and seniors like to settle down. Thanks to its proximity to the Island of Montreal, its low tax rate, its many parks and green spaces, and its abundance of stores and services... it's a win-win situation for everyone," said Mayor Guy Pilon.

To accommodate this growth in population, several elementary schools have been built recently and a new high school is currently underway in the in the Dorion sector, a neighborhood undergoing a major revitalization with many investments being made and which is sure to attract people to come settle in the coming years. The future Vaudreuil-Soulanges Hospital, close to the Vaudreuil train station, is also expected to bring new residents to this area which features rental buildings, senior homes and condominiums.

"Vaudreuil-Dorion has developed rapidly, but our goal is always the same: to offer citizens, all generations considered, a social living environment with a variety of quality services," concluded Mayor Pilon.
