Publication of the historical book Vaudreuil-Dorion: la fusion de nos histoires

Vaudreuil-Dorion, February 25, 2022 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to announce that the book entitled *Vaudreuil-Dorion: la fusion de nos histoires,* created by Le Musée régional de Vaudreuil-Soulanges to mark the 25th anniversary of the merger of the cities of Vaudreuil and Dorion, has just been published by Les Éditions GID. History buffs, but also all citizens curious to learn more about their City, can now buy their copy at the museum or in local bookstores. The book is also available to borrow from the municipal library.

This photo book compiled from the *100 ans noir sur blanc collection* offers a journey back in time, an illustrated tour of the history of Vaudreuil-Dorion across a little more than 200 pages. "The idea of publishing this book to shine a spotlight on its collection of historical photographs began during the festivities surrounding the 25th anniversary of the merger. We wanted these beautiful photos depicting the richness of our heritage to be accessible to everyone, and most of all, allow us to remember the builders of our City. I would like to acknowledge the exceptional work of Édith Prégent, Sébastien Daviau and Jean-Luc Brazeau. I hope you will enjoy leafing through this expertly-made document as much as I do", said Mayor Guy Pilon.
