The Vaudreuil-Dorion Treasure Hunt is back! Registration begins on May 2nd

Vaudreuil-Dorion, April 26, 2022 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to announce the return of the Treasure Hunt for the fourth consecutive year. The event will take place on Sunday, May 15th. Citizens wishing to give unwanted objects a second life are asked to place them at the curb starting at 8 a.m. Those interested in these treasures will be able to claim them at no cost on a first-come, first-served basis.

To participate, residents must sign up with the Environment Department between **May 2nd and 10th** by e-mailing **environnement@ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca** or calling 450 455-3371, option 1. They will be asked to indicate their address and describe the objects they plan on offering: furniture, appliances, toys, dishes, cultural objects (music, literature, art), electronic devices, bathroom items, tools and materials or more. The addresses collected, along with the types of objects available, will be posted on the City's website on Friday, May 13th.

Please note that any items that have not been claimed must be picked up before 9 p.m. the night of the event. Hazardous household waste as well as unprotected sharp or pointy items will not be accepted for this activity, which will take place rain or shine.

The Treasure Hunt is in line with the 3RD principle (reduction at source, reuse, recycling and development of residual material), and makes it possible to increase the life of objects, limit the production of new products and avoid the disposal of perfectly functional items in landfills.
