Mon premier 405: A Showcase for Amateur Artists from Vaudreuil-Dorion

Vaudreuil-Dorion, May 10, 2022 – As part of Le 405's summer programming, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is inviting local artists to share their passion with the public on the park's outdoor stage. Interested candidates have until **May 31st, 4:30 p.m.**, to submit their application.

Thursday nights from July 7th to August 25th, between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., the stage at Le 405 will belong to emerging artists who want to share their talents with the public in the hour preceding a comedy show. This call for proposals is aimed at singers, musical groups, dancers, actors, magicians, comedians and any other performing artist, regardless of their age.

"Le 405 has succeeded in winning the hearts of Vaudreuil-Dorion residents. Mon premier 405 is simply a new opportunity for them to make the place their own while giving them a window to showcase their art," says Vincent Bastien, Director of Recreation and Culture.

To be eligible, interested persons must meet the following criteria: Be a resident of Vaudreuil-Dorion, be available on at least two Thursday evenings between July 7th and August 25th, be able to perform for a period of 15 to 45 minutes and provide all the equipment required.

To submit your application, simply fill out the registration form available on the City's website at ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca and send a 2 to 6 minute video of the performance to **mbeauchamp@ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca**. To make sure the documents are received, we recommend using a file transfer service (WeTransfer, Dropbox, etc.).

A selection committee will be responsible for choosing the winning performances based on their quality, originality and how well they fit in with the programming.
