## Passeport culturel: A project for introducing the arts to the citizens of Vaudreuil-Dorion

**Vaudreuil-Dorion**, **June 21**, **2022** – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is launching a brand new range of activities called *Passeport culturel*. The program serves as an introduction to a variety of artistic disciplines, and activities will be presented throughout the summer in the form of four separate workshops aimed at young people aged 12 to 17.

Consequently, every Friday afternoon, from July 15th to August 5th, teenagers will have an opportunity to discover a new art discipline taught by a professional, including a customized approach to transforming clothing, a workshop for the creation of an art project, hip-hop dancing and storytelling. The get-togethers will take place at Le Bunker, located at Parc Paul-Gérin-Lajoie.

"The goal of this project is to allow citizens to discover the different forms of art through initiation. We chose to target teenagers this summer and we are pleased to offer them these four workshops. In the fall, we plan to repeat the experience, this time with seniors. As with the target clientele, the type and number of activities are expected to vary each season," explained Chloé Marcil, Head of the Culture and Community Life division.

Interested youths are invited to visit Le Bunker on June 27th to sign up. A prize worth \$300 in gift certificates from local merchants will be drawn among all participants at the end of the summer.

This project is being carried out as part of the 2021-2024 cultural development agreement between the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion and the *Ministère de la Culture et des Communications du Québec*.
