Vaudreuil-Dorion to host the exhibition *Contamination Culturelle*

Vaudreuil-Dorion, September 20, 2022 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is pleased to announce that the outdoor travelling exhibition entitled *Contamination Culturelle*, an initiative of the *Conseil des arts et de la culture de Vaudreuil-Soulanges (CACVS)*, will be on display at Parc de la Maison-Valois until October 16th.

Since the summer of 2021, *Contamination Culturelle* has featured the work of 20 artists as part of two parallel routes that have been travelling throughout the Vaudreuil-Soulanges region, namely the Blue Circuit and the Green Circuit. In 2022, the exhibition will visit 12 municipalities across the region and will be introducing a collection of 20 new works.

The Green Circuit

The Green Circuit, presented in Vaudreuil-Dorion, brings together the work of artists Caroline Forget, Jibé Laurin, Raquel Maciel, Sophie Ouellet, Agnès Robin, Les Sorcières de Soulanges (Monica Brinkman, Diane Collet, Valéry Filion, Christiane Flores and Annick Gauvreau), Johanne Mitchell, Luc Sauvé, Miguel Rioux and Tina Marais Struthers.

"We are honoured to be hosting this regional exhibition in one of our busiest parks, Parc de la Maison-Valois. There is no doubt that the works of these talented artists will catch the attention of visitors. I invite all citizens to stop by the exhibition before October 16th and discover what *Contamination Culturelle* is all about," said Guy Pilon, Mayor of Vaudreuil-Dorion.

After its stop in Vaudreuil-Dorion, the exhibition will conclude its 2022 summer tour in L'Île-Cadieux.

The Blue Circuit

The exhibition began in Sainte-Marthe. It will be at Les Coteaux until October 16th before making a last stop in Saint-Polycarpe to conclude its tour.
