This Halloween, Make Way for the Frightful Circus!

Vaudreuil-Dorion, October 11, 2022 – The City of Vaudreuil-Dorion is launching its programming for the two-day Halloween festivities that will take place on October 28th and 29th. The public is invited to pay a visit to the Haunted House at *Opticentre St-Jean-Baptiste* (145 boulevard Harwood) and participate in the various thematic activities offered at the library.

"We are excited to be offering an activity program for Halloween again this year. Considering the poor weather last year, we decided to hold part of the activities indoors this time to ensure everyone's comfort. We hope to see many of you there! », said Vincent Bastien, Director of Recreation and Culture.

Opticentre St-Jean-Baptiste

On both Friday, October 28th, from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m., and Saturday, October 29th, from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m., citizens are invited to visit the Haunted House and participate in the carnival games that will be located outside the *Opticentre*. This year, the theme for the Haunted House will be l'effroyable cirque (Frightful Circus) where guests might just run into mysterious characters such as the Fortune Teller, the Magician and the Strong Man.

On Friday, October 28th, the *Opticentre* will host a movie night featuring the film *La Famille Adams 2* at 7 p.m. and the horror film *It* (French version) at 9:30 p.m. for viewers aged 13 and over. Non-alcoholic drinks and snacks will be available for sale on site from 6:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.

On Saturday, October 29th, the doors of the *Opticentre* will open at 7 p.m. to make way for the costume party with music provided by DJ Adrien Tosti. Then, at 8 p.m., Lady Beats, featuring the duo composed of percussionist and Belle et Bum co-host, Mélissa Lavergne, and *DJ Abeille*, an experienced DJ and former VJ for *Musiqueplus*, will hit the stage and lure the crowd to the dance floor. Bar service will be available from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. Because places are limited for this event, those interested in participating are urged to register online at ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca starting October 24th until October 27th. People who show up in a costume are eligible to win prizes in our Costume Contest.
