Lumin'Art is back with an even more breathtaking third edition!

Vaudreuil-Dorion, Novembre 21, 2022 – For the third consecutive year, the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion will be hosting the Lumin'Art art exhibition at Parc Le 405. Starting on December 1st, the public is invited to come discover *Reflet*, Lumin'Art's brand new collection, which has been added to the works created in 2020 and 2021.

In this year's rendition, *Reflet* plays with the shapes, spirit and creativity inspired by individuals. A total of 36 work of which 28 were created by artists from Vaudreuil-Soulanges and 8 by students from Vaudreuil-Dorion schools, will each provide insight into a different world. Simultaneously, well-known photographer Christian Gonzalez will be paying tribute to La Baie de Vaudreuil through his exhibition entitled *Reflet sur la baie*. Added to this will be the giant lanterns created last year and the Christmas Balls decorated by artists in 2020. It should be noted that the lanterns made by children had been damaged, and as a result will unfortunately not be included in this year's exhibition.

"Bedecking Parc Le 405 with art and light just before the Holiday Season produces a simply magical environment. This exhibition was an immediate success in 2020 and has been growing every year since. I am truly looking forward to the much-anticipated unveiling on December 1st, and I invite all citizens of Vaudreuil-Dorion to come and admire the works of our artists," said Chloé Marcil, Head of Culture and Community Life for the City of Vaudreuil-Dorion.

The unveiling of the Lumin'Art exhibition will take place on December 1st at 7 p.m. The event will run until February 1st. To fully appreciate the experience, guests are urged to visit after 4 p.m., once the sun has set. On Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays, hot drinks will be served starting at 5 p.m. The music, assembled exclusively for Lumin'Art by the composer Christian Leclair, will enhance the visit.
