Spring Break in Vaudreuil-Dorion promises fun and activities for every taste

Vaudreuil-Dorion, January 24, 2023 – Vaudreuil-Dorion will be hosting a wide range of activities for its residents during Spring Break, from March 6th to 10th, 2023. Parents will be able to choose between two different options being offered by the City: Full Day camp, with online registration beginning on February 8th at 9 a.m., or one-time activities, with registration starting at noon on February 15th on the City's website at ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca.

Day Camp

The Spring Break Day Camp is open to Vaudreuil-Dorion residents aged five to twelve, and will take place at the *Centre Sportif du Campus de la Cité-des-Jeunes* (400 avenue Saint-Charles). The camp schedule will be from Monday to Friday - 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., and daycare services will be available from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Throughout the week, kids will accompany the fictional character *Docteur Atomique*, an internationally renowned scientist, on a quest that will take them back to different periods of the past thanks to a time machine. The program will include activities in the gym and outdoors, as well as sports and cooperative games.

One-time activities

From March 6th to 10th, citizens will also have the opportunity to participate in about forty à la carte activities organized by the City, including workshops, learning activities, individual take-home kits, as well as drop-in activities, sports and outdoor play. Space is limited, and registration is required for most of the activities. The child's citizen card will be required at the time of registration starting at noon on February 15th. Some activities are offered free of charge, while others require a registration fee.

Skating and free swim

Citizens who wish to do so will be able to skate free of charge at the municipal arena (*9 rue Jeannotte*) from Monday to Friday - 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (*glace Vaudreuil*) and from 1:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. (*glace Dorion*). As for the indoor pool (*400 avenue Saint-Charles, pavilion J*), free swim periods will be taking on a tropical vibe. The schedule will be available in early February on the City's website in the Indoor Pool section.

Throughout the whole week of Spring Break, kids are also invited to visit the library (*51 rue Jeannotte*) to create digital projects at the *Lab.* Operating hours for this creative space will be from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Monday, March 6th, from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 7th and from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. from March 8th to March 10th.
