Revision of the urban plan and bylaws: the *Ville de Vaudreuil-Dorion* consults its population

Vaudreuil-Dorion, July 3, 2025 – To ensure the concordance of its urban planning bylaws, within the framework of the coming into force of the revised Schéma d'aménagement et de développement of the MRC de Vaudreuil-Soulanges, the municipal council of the *Ville de Vaudreuil-Dorion* adopted draft bylaws on June 16. The public is invited to consult draft urban plan no. 1870, as well as the amendments and urban planning bylaws, and to share their comments during a public consultation period.

This obligation to harmonize urban planning tools provides an opportunity to update the vision of land use and development, as well as the regulatory framework for its implementation. The revision of the urban plan and by-laws consists in producing new planning and regulatory documents for land use planning, replacing those currently in force, which are more than 23 years old.

"The revision of our urban plan is much more than a compliance exercise. It's an opportunity to reaffirm our collective vision for the future of Vaudreuil-Dorion. Through this process, we wanted to update the tools that frame the development of our territory, considering current realities, emerging needs and the aspirations of our population. Public consultation period

Two public consultation meetings on the draft by-laws will be held on September 9 and 10, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 2 of the Centre multisports André-Chagnon, located at 3093, boulevard de la Gare, 2nd floor, Vaudreuil-Dorion. To participate, registration is recommended, by e-mail to revisionurbanisme@ ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca, by September 5 at 12 p.m. In addition to these public consultation mee-tings, the City is offering two consultation activities, either in writing or in person.

It should be remembered that, independently of the legal obligations requiring public consultation, the *Ville de Vaudreuil-Dorion* carried out a participatory approach prior to the revision process. The consultation report is available online.
