Participants will also have a chance to win numerous prizes, including games, books, gift certificates, e-readers, and many other surprises. The Summer BiblioClub also features a drawing contest, arts-and-crafts activities, park events organized by the Caravane Mozaïk, and a closing party to be held on August 30 at the library.
