Hay May	Is your home or trailer ready for the summer season? <u>Do you have:</u> • a smoke detector; • a carbon monoxide detector; • a portable fire extinguisher (5 lbs)?	
June	Is your BBQ located at least 1 meter or more from any combustible structure, according to the manufacturer's instructions? Did you service and clean the BBQ before turning it on? <u>A few tips</u>	
July	Have you advised any guests who smoke to NEVER extinguish their cigarettes in any mulch, garden beds or flower pots? <u>Did you know that even soil and mulch can burn?</u>	
August	Are you always close by to keep an eye on the stove when it's on? Do you have access to an extinguishing method, such as a fitted lid, to extinguish a cooking fire? Do you know how to prevent false alarms caused by cooking vapours? Information	
September	Have you had your chimney checked and cleaned to detect the presence of creosote or bird nests? Do you have a carbon monoxide detector within 5 m of your bedrooms if you have a garage attached to the house or if you have a fuel burning or gas-fired appliance? Have you pressed the test button?
